## 2007 Hyde Vineyard Carneros Pinot Noir

“You have to be a passionate wine enthusiast to appreciate the meaning of ‘Hyde’ and ‘Carneros’ and ‘Pinot Noir.’ This is superstar stuff on all accounts. Larry Hyde developed the Hyde-Wente clone of Pinot Noir (and Chardonnay). This Patz & Hall Pinot is strawberries, kirsch, cherries and dark chocolate on the nose. On the palate, the acidity is balanced by the bold fruit and chalky tannins, and blast of alcohol. The backbone of acidity that supports the fruit shouts Carneros. Texture is dense and creamy. This is iconic Pinot Noir.”
